

Kidscape is funded from voluntary donations – please help to secure our future by leaving a gift to us in your will.

Writing a will does not need to be complicated, but we recommend that you consult a solicitor to ensure your will accurately reflects your intentions as there are two options for you to consider:

- Pecuniary bequest – a donation of a fixed sum of money.
- Residuary bequest – a gift of all or a percentage of your estate after all other payments and bequests have been made.

The following statement contains all the necessary wording to make sure Kidscape receives your gift, and should be included in your will:

I give to Kidscape Campaign for Children's Safety, 8-10 South Street, Epsom, Surrey KT18 7PF Registered Charity Number 326864 (state the % residue or sum of money you wish to give) and request without obligation that it be used at the discretion of the trustees for immediate or future needs.

- We will be sensitive, professional and courteous at all times.

the Goodwill Partnership

Kidscape has partnered with The Goodwill Partnership to make it as easy as possible for you to write your will. The Goodwill Partnership is available in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. You'll be visited at home by a trained professional at a time to suit you (including evenings and weekends). They will note your instructions and pass them on to the panel solicitor who will provide your will. This will cost £108 + VAT for a single will (the lowest price for a face-to-face will writing service in England and Wales). There is no obligation to leave a gift to Kidscape by using this service, although we would of course be very grateful if you chose to support us in this way.

A message from a supporter

I recently celebrated my 68th birthday, but about 15 months ago I was diagnosed with PTSD after asking my GP for help with depression.

This depression dates back to my childhood during which I suffered many instances of both mental and physical bullying, mainly at the hands of my elder brother but also at the hands of my father who was all too ready to see the worst in me and raise his hand to me.

In the Fifties and Sixties, there wasn't anywhere for me to gain some kind of sanctuary, indeed I didn't seek sanctuary as what I was going through was the norm. The only sanctuary for me I slowly discovered was solitude.

As I entered my fifties, it became obvious that I was not going to be one of the many men who settle down and have children to pass on their legacy to. I looked around for a charity that I could relate to, so that I could leave my legacy to them. By searching the internet I found Kidscape and became a donor.

The objective of leaving a legacy for a charity like Kidscape is to help to provide the kind of support to young children that was not available to me when I needed help. Abuse will always happen unfortunately, to help those who suffer from abuse as I did is the least I can do.
