- Respond appropriately to suspicion or knowledge that a child may be at risk of harm
- Deal appropriately with disclosures

- Navigate the child protection system and define the professional roles within it
- Understand and recognise the different types of abuse that children can be subjected to
- Have a basic knowledge of the signs and symptoms that may indicate the abuse of a child
- Know how to respond to child protection concerns and disclosures
- Understand the procedures professionals should follow when abuse is suspected
